JOB DESCRIPTION



Fleet Captain Racing

General description:

Annually elected by the membership at the AGM, this position is responsible for leadership and overall administration of racing activities, to include the Club racing program, Club-sponsored regattas and International One Metre events.

Specific responsibilities: (in addition to the Duties and Responsibilities of members of the Board)

- 1. Serve on the Board of Directors, with the general responsibilities of Board members and in accordance with Board policies and procedures;
- 2. Appoint a Race Committee to assist with the organization and operation of the Club racing program, delegating to members of the Committee responsibility for club handicaps, race direction, race results and reports;
- 3. Schedule and organize the Club racing program and Club participation in regattas and other racing events, in consultation with the Race Committee;
- 4. Update the Club yearbook including the Racing Schedule, Racing Procedures and Racing Results table;
- 5. Publicize the racing activities of the club through reports in Telltales and other local media;
- 6. Direct the annual Round Saltspring Island Race, appointing a RSI Chairman and delegating responsibility as appropriate to the Race Officer and RSI Race Committee;
- 7. Direct the Opening Day Sail Past and the New Year's Day Race in liaison with the Staff Captain with respect to the food and beverage component of these events;
- 8. Organize Club participation in special racing events (e.g. Vendee, Interclub);
- 9. Manage racing trophies and awards, in cooperation with other Club Officers who are responsible for Club awards and award events and;
- 10. Manage the use¹, maintenance and replacement of equipment used in racing events and activities.
