Friday, May 18 (BBQ dinner)

3 pm to 8:45 pm: 14-16 volunteers needed to do food preparation and serving

5 pm to 10 pm: 12 volunteers needed to serve and do clean up

Saturday, May 19 (continental breakfast)

6 am to 9:30 am: 8 volunteers needed (2 to do coffee and the rest to do food preparation and clean up)

Sunday, May 20 (Lions Club pancake breakfast)

8 am to 1 pm: 10 volunteers (2 to do coffee and the rest to help prepare and serve breakfast)

11 am to 2 pm: 6 volunteers needed to do clean up

Wednesday, May 16 (set up team #1)

2 pm to 4 pm: 4 volunteers needed to start set up (signage, tables and chairs, tents, extension cords, garbage cans, construct stage, blockade driveway, etc.)

Thursday, May 17 (set up team #2)

10 am to 2 pm: 6 volunteers to finish set up (same jobs as Wednesday; some of the Wednesday team may be asked to help on this day if the tents are not there to put up on Wednesday)

Friday, May 18 (race registration and dinner, 2 overlapping shifts)

3 pm to 7 pm: 5 volunteers needed to supervise garbage, recycling, monitoring portable toilets and handwashing station, directing traffic, clean up, moving clothing for sale.

5 pm to 9 pm: 5 volunteers needed to do the same duties as the first shift

Saturday, May 19 (race day, 4 overlapping shifts)

6 am to 8 am: 2 volunteers needed to make and set up coffee

8 am to 10 am: 2 volunteers needed to keep the coffee going

6 am to 10 am: 4 volunteers to do general work such as set up PA system, supervise garbage, recycling, monitoring portable toilets and handwashing station, clean up, moving clothing for sale

9 am to 12 noon: 4 volunteers needed to carry on with general work as in previous shift

Sunday, May 20 (race finish, awards presentations, and clean up)

7 am to 11 am: 5 volunteers needed to help with coffee, set up PA system, supervise garbage, recycling, monitoring portable toilets and handwashing station, clean up, moving clothing for sale, clean up tables and chairs, put cords, signs, etc. away

9 am to 2 pm: 5 volunteers needed to carry on with work as in previous shift
