APPLYING FOR JUNIOR MEMBERSHIP

Background and Application Procedure

Program Information

The Saltspring Island Sailing Club Junior Program is open to youth from 7 to 18 years of age. The program runs year-round, and features seasonal evening activities including Fun Sails, Racing and Family Sails. In addition, a full week of activities is offered during a summer Junior Week, when the Club dinghy fleet is reserved exclusively for Juniors. The Club's active programs of racing and junior sail training, as well as a social program, provide an opportunity to meet a wide variety of very interesting people who can become lifelong friends.

Junior Membership Privileges and Responsibilities

Junior members do not have voting or mooring rights, but enjoy a range of Club privileges and responsibilities. Initiation fees and annual membership for the Junior Program have been kept low as we are a volunteer club with most of the work undertaken by members – including Junior Members. There is an expectation that Junior Members will participate actively in the program and contribute a minimum of 20 hours of their time each year to assist at the two annual Work Parties, attend training sessions, and work to develop a lifelong set of skills in the practice of sailing. The Junior Program is governed by Regulation 8 found in the Club's annual Yearbook.

Fees

Initiation fees to join as a Junior Member are \$50.00 plus 5% GST for a total of **\$52.50**. This includes annual dues to May 31 in the year following the date of joining.

Annual membership fees are \$75.00 plus 5% GST for a total of **\$78.75**. These are payable for the period June 1 to May 31 of the following year.

Other user fees, and costs for participation in specific activities, may also be applicable.

Application Requirements

A completed application includes the attached form along with a cheque for the initial initiation fee, a copy of your birth certificate or other proof of age, and a Release and Indemnity Agreement signed by your Parent/Guardian. These should be provided personally or by mail to:
