STUDENT EQUIPMENT LIST

Students should bring the following equipment each day:

- A Transport Canada approved PFD (life jacket). A student cannot sail without a properly fitted PFD.
- Whistle
- Closed-toed shoes (no sandals – open-toed shoes may catch on lines)
- Two changes of clothes
- Windbreaker
- Sunscreen, sunglasses (with a strap), and a hat
- Water bottle
- Swimsuit
- Towel
- A packed lunch

Optional items:

- A child's wetsuit (inexpensive ones are available at big box stores)
- Binoculars for the visiting parent to watch the activity on the water
- T-shirts, caps and other items will be available for sale at the course opening
