
## Flying Fifteen Update June 17, 2024

The Flying Fifteen group is expecting a container from Australia with four donated Flying Fifteens in it to arrive on Saltspring sometime in late June or early July. (As of mid June, the container had left Perth and arrived in Indonesia, soon to be enroute to Vancouver.). In preparation for equipping the four new boats to sail safely in local waters, the group is looking for the following donations from the sailing community:

- 1. Four horns
- 2. Two whistles
- 3. Four packages of small Flares, 3 flares per package
- 4. Four small smoke signal canisters
- 5. Four Heaving Lines in Bags, approximately 15 meters, 8 mm floating line (eg. a heaving line used for kayaks)
- 6. Four small waterproof flashlights or headlamps
- 7. One package of 20 AA rechargeable batteries
- 8. Four, 2-litre waterproof bags
- 9. Four Dock Line 15' each with clip on one end
- 10. Four Dock Line 25' each with clip on one end

- 11. Four Dock Line 30' each with clip on one end
- 12. Four 1" eye, 3" long screw in eye bolt, approximate size
- 13. Eight 1" brass or anti-rust shackles
- 14. Eight 1/2" safety rings
- 15. 12 (3 per boat x four boats) brass or anti-rust clips
- 16. 25' of 1/4" or 3/16" black elastic/bungee cord
- 17. Eight (2 per boat x 4 boats) medium sized fenders black or white
- 18. Four (1 per boat x 4 boats) large sized fenders black or white we have 8 small fenders
- 19. Four kayak paddles that can be split into two pieces, two halves per boat or 8 small canoe or dinghy paddles
- 20. Three small, eg 3" x 5", emergency first aid kit with first aid manual
- 21. One container of West System 407, 403, 310, and 406 fiberglass repair material
- 22. One container of fiberglass epoxy
- 23. 2 VHF handheld radios (already have received two)
